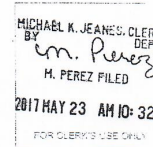

The Court has read the sworn or affirmed Petition for Permanent Appointment of a Guardian of a Minor and held a hearing to determine whether the Court should enter the Order requested in the Petition.

THE COURT FINDS:

- PETITION FILED.** Petitioner filed with the Court a sworn Petition pursuant to A.R.S. § 14-5201, et seq., for Appointment of a Permanent Guardian for the minor named above (the "Minor"), and is entitled to file the Petition pursuant to A.R.S. § 14-5207(A);
- JURISDICTION AND VENUE.** Both jurisdiction and venue are proper before this Court, A.R.S. §§ 14-5102, 14-5205;
- NOTICE.** Petitioner has given Notice of Hearing as required by A.R.S. § 14-5207 and other applicable law, or all interested parties have waived Notice of Hearing.
- MINOR'S BEST INTERESTS:** All parental rights of custody have been terminated or suspended by circumstances or prior court order, and Minor's welfare and best interests require the appointment of a Permanent Guardian to provide for his or her continuing care and supervision, A.R.S. §§ 14-5204, 14-5207;
