Decorating Birthday Dreams Bags

Arizona Helping Hands (AHH) provides a custom decorated bag to make each child feel special and loved on their birthday. These bags will be used for boys and girls turning 1-12. There is a \$1 donation for every bag picked up to cover material costs.

SUPPLIES

- ✓ White Birthday Bag (pick up at AHH)
- Birthday Bag Traceable Templates (pick up at AHH)
- Coloring Supplies

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Collect birthday bags and templates from AHH.
- 2) Decorate both sides of the white bag.
- 3) Include "Happy Birthday" on at least one side of the bag.
- 4) Return completed bags to AHH.



Arizona Helping Hands (AHH) provides a Birthday Party in a Bag with all of our Birthday Dreams gift packages. Many children in foster care have never had the opportunity to celebrate a birthday before. A Birthday Party in a Bag provides a child with a celebration to accompany the gifts they receive.

Supplies

- Birthday Bag
- Boxed Cake Mix
- 1 Tub Cake Frosting
- ✓ 1 Aluminum Cake Pan
- 1 Pack Birthday Candles
- Minimum of 4 Birthday Decorations (streamers, balloons, party favors, hats, etc.)
- Optional: Encouraging non-religious note

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Collect or purchase the items listed above.
- 2) Fill the birthday bag with all the items.
- 3) Optional: Write a non-religious birthday message to place in the birthday bag.
- 4) Return completed bags to AHH.

Hygiene Kits

Arizona Helping Hands (AHH) provides children with a safe place to sleep and more, including twin beds, cribs, clothing, diapers, wipes, educational activities, and personal hygiene kits. These kits make sure children in foster care have the important basic needs they often leave home without.

SUPPLIES

- ✓ Toothpaste
- ✓ Toothbrush
- ✓ Floss
- ✓ Hairbrush/Comb
- Plastic shoe box sized tub or nylon drawstring backpack to hold everything. (The tub is preferred.)
- Optional: Encouraging non-religious note
- ✓ Optional: Hair ties for girls

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Collect or purchase the items listed above.
- 2) Place one of each item into the nylon drawstring backpack or plastic tub.
- 3) Optional: Write a nonreligious encouraging message to place in the hygiene kit.
- 4) Optional: Add hair ties for girls, please mark these kits.
- 5) Return completed kits to AHH.

Baby Stroller / Tummy Time Blankets

Arizona Helping Hands (AHH) can always use blankets for babies in foster care. These blankets provide a safe space for babies to lay on for tummy time as well as keep them warm in their strollers. Instructions on how to make a no-sew tie blanket are included below. Quilts and knitted blankets are also welcome.

SUPPLIES

- 2 pieces of coordinating fleece, 1.5 yards each (or larger, depending on the size blanket you want to make)
- Scissors
- Measuring Tape



ESTIMATED COMPLETION TIME: 1.5 hours - 1 Blanket

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Cut fleece: Cut your fabric down to the size you want it but add 4 inches. (If you want a 3-foot by 2-foot blanket, you will cut the fabric to 3-foot 4 inches by 2-foot 4 inches.)
- 2) Arrange fleece: Make sure both pieces of fabric are pointing out and lay one on top of the other.
- 3) Cut slits: Start making 1-inch wide and 3-inch-long slits along one side of the blanket. When you get to the end of each side, you will want to cut a 3-inch by 3-inch square in the corners.
- 4) Tie strips: Start tying your strips of fabric by making a circle with the two strips together and then pulling the end through the circle. Work your way down until you have tied all sides of the blanket.
- 5) Return completed blankets to AHH.



Drawstring Pillowcases

Arizona Helping Hands (AHH) uses drawstring pillowcases to hold items such as clothing and shoes for children and teens in foster care that we serve.

SUPPLIES

- Pillowcase
- ✓ 1 yard of 1cm wide grosgrain ribbon
- Seam ripper
- Safety pin
- Needle and thread
- ✓ Optional: Sewing machine



ESTIMATED COMPLETION TIME: 1 hour - 2 Pillowcases

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Take your pillowcase and turn it inside out. Use your seam ripper to split one side seam 5cm (2") from the top. This split creates the opening to thread your ribbon through to make the drawstring.
- 2) Fold the top of the pillowcase over 2.5cm (1") and press with the Iron. Stitch all the way around by hand or with your sewing machine to create your casing.
- 3) Take your ribbon and use a safety pin to thread your ribbon through the casing.
- 4) Turn your pillowcase right side out.
- 5) Return completed pillowcases to AHH.



Collection Drives

- BIRTHDAY PARTY IN A BAG DRIVE Oftentimes, children in foster care have never had the opportunity to celebrate a birthday. A Birthday Party in a Bag provides a child with a celebration to accompany the gifts they receive.
- **BOOK DRIVE** Each year, AHH promotes literacy by providing thousands of books to children in foster care.
- **CLOTHING DRIVE** Children in foster care often leave home with nothing but the clothes on their backs. Each year, AHH gives 4,000+ children in foster care a fresh start with essential items, like clothing.

- **DIAPER DRIVE** In an average week, AHH provides 3,000+ diapers and 2,500+ wipes to children in foster care.
- THYGIENE ITEMS DRIVE Each year, AHH provides 4,000+ hygiene kits to children in foster care to help them feel confident and healthy.
- PAJAMA DRIVE Children in foster care often leave home with nothing but the clothes on their backs. Each year, AHH gives 4,000+ children in foster care a fresh start with essential items, like pajamas.
- **TOY DRIVE** Each year, AHH provides 3,000+ birthday packages to celebrate children in foster care, lifting their self-esteem.
